



FROM THE PASTOR

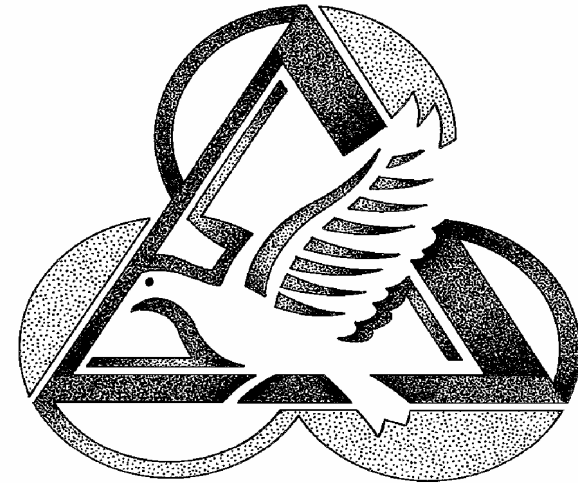
It is a blessing to have you in worship with us today. We trust that you will witness the presence of God among us and join us in lifting up the name of the Lord Jesus Christ.
